CALEA Accreditation:

Old Business:

CONN PAC website: Chief Palmer working on gathering documents and helpful web links to put on the website as references.

New Business:

CALEA Assessor Refresher Training: (Linda Carlin) Touched on PowerDMS. The first agency using PowerDMS got accredited at the July Conference.

Standards Review: (Linda Carlin)

Campus Security:

4.3.7: Prior to appointment requires a medical exam

24.1.9: All Hazard Training went from optional to mandatory for A size agencies.

Communications:

61.2.14, 6.4.1, 6.4.2, Chapter 7: Changes to standard or commentary

Law Enforcement:

46.1.9: All Hazard Training went from optional to mandatory for A size agencies.

72.4.5: Changed check of holding cells prior to and immediately after each use of the cell to regularly scheduled checks.

72.8.2: Changed Removing the possibility of invading detainee privacy to reduce unnecessary invasion of detainee personal privacy.

82.1.6: Commentary change: Automated systems suffice for c) access security, and d) password audits.

Future review and/or changes:

CALEA is in the process of completing draft standard for domestic violence to address officer involved domestics: November 2012

CALEA is in the process of reviewing License plate reader regarding training, access and retention. Discussion November 2012

CALEA will be reviewing the eyewitness identification standard.

PAC Presidents Meeting: (Chief Palmer): Craig Hartley and Karen Shepard presented. There will be a refocus on outcomes. Program managers are now salespersons for bringing agencies into the CALEA process and are asking members to do the same. If agency brings another agency into the process they will receive up to 10% off their next reaccreditation.

Mandatory video taping of interviews: Chief State's attorney still evaluating specifications for what will be required. It is still possible that the State may pay for the required equipment. There may be a cost savings if purchased before July.

CALEA Assessors: Signed non conflict agreement in the past which prevents them from assisting with State mock unless the agency is pursuing CALEA accreditation. At most recent assessor training, individuals were not asked to sign the agreement.

Redding PD looking for a State Mock, but not a CONNPAC member so will be charged.

Hamden PD is hiring a civilian accreditation manager.

Motion to adjourn made by Monroe and seconded by CSP. Meeting adjourned.

Chief Palmer gave a Power DMS training/presentation after the meeting was adjourned.
