Old Business:

CALEA update: Frisco, Tx Conference: Norwalk, UCONN and Capitol Police reaccredited.

SRIC: New Standard 4.3.5: Firearm ranges: applies if you have or use a firearms range. Must wear ballistic vest during training.

Standard 84.2.6: Prisoner checks: 30 minute checks via video with physical check every hour.

New Standard on Use of Force investigations: Criminal and administrative investigation in serious injury and death cases must address in policy and training.

Paul McMillan encourages members to comment on the CALEA forum.

There will be no November 2018 conference and no summer 2019 CALEA conference.

POSTC Update:

Subcommittee is recommending Certificate of Compliance to Law Enforcement Standards and Practices to be mandatory for all state agencies: 46 Standards, 40 are from Tier I other 6 are either from other Tiers or new. New standards are state mandates. Looking to present to POST Council May 10th meeting. Agencies will be required to come into compliance by July 2020. PowerDMS will be recommended but not required and will cost \$600 for new agencies. Training on program and PowerDMS will be provided at POST.
