

CONNAPAC MEETING MINUTES

Date: December 1, 2016

Location: Four Points Sheraton, Meridan, CT

Secretary's Report: Minutes of October 6th meeting presented for review. Motion made by Farmington and seconded by Coventry to accept minutes as presented. Vote: Unanimous. Motion carries.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report presented. Balance is \$1,153.64. Motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented made by POSTC and seconded by CSP. Vote: Unanimous. Motion carried. Currently 35 agencies have paid 2016-2017 dues.

Old Business: Mock Onsite:

Guilford looking for a mock January 19, 2017.

Simsbury is scheduled for a mock January 11, 2017.

Onsites: Madison Onsite starts December 11. Call in and Public hearing will be December 12th. They will be the 1st Communications Center accredited in CT.

CALEA update: Paul McMillian: 6th Edition (5.2.4 in Power DMS) will likely come out at the March Conference. Many Chapter and Standard numbers are changing but is told the transition will be seamless. Many comments were posted regarding the proposed changes and they were taken into consideration. The new four year cycle, Departments will get contacted within 3 months of the accreditation anniversary date. Thirty days notice will be given with what files will be looked at. Time sensitive standards are always considered crucial and will be looked at yearly.

Bloomfield received a list of 25% of the standards that would be reviewed from the CSM. CSM put 16 of the 125 standards out of compliance. McMillian reports he was previously told that non compliance would not be used anymore however Bloomfield's review shows otherwise. Under current system the standard will stay in non compliance for a year until the next review.

Conference in Charleston, SC, Nov. 2-5, 2016. Enfield stated at the Presidents meeting they stated they were taking the comments on the Standards seriously. Chief Kulhawik states he commented on four standards and all were not implemented. Enfield was told the transition policy is that you can finish a full cycle before transitioning to the 6th edition.

POST Update: B. Tanner advises Redding is due but hasn't heard from them to schedule.

Training: Captain Silver has agreed to be the training coordinator. She has contacted 26 PACs and sent out survey to our PAC members. Only 10 PAC members have responded. Need the remainder of members to respond to determine the training interests and needs.

New Business:

Chief Palmer was appointed to the POST Council by the governor.

Motion made by POST and seconded by CSP to adjourn. Vote unanimous. Meeting Adjourned.
