

CONN PAC MEETING MINUTES

Date: June 6, 2019

Secretary's Report: Minutes of April 14, 2019 meeting presented for review. Motion made by POSTC and seconded by Madison to accept minutes as presented. Vote: Unanimous.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report presented by J. Parker. Balance is \$3673.63. Motion to accept the report as presented made by POSTC and seconded by East Hartford. Vote: Unanimous.

Old Business:

On-sites: East Hartford completed Tier I onsite June 5th.

Mock On-sites: CSP looking to have a mock at the end of August.

CALEA Conference: Huntsville, AL: East Haven received their initial accreditation award

CALEA Update: Paul Macmillan is at the New Hampshire Chief's expo so not able to attend this meeting. Chief Kulhawik advised the CALEA recommends using Internet Explorer not Firefox for CIMRS data entry. Chief Kulhawik advises for an onsite he just went on the CSM did not sign off on 17 files although at the onsite assessors were able to sign off on all. CSM was trying to require for ticket accountability, to account for ticket that had been signed out but not yet used.

POSTC Update:

Accreditation manager training will be scheduled for either July 11th or 12th. Assessor training still needs to be scheduled. W. Tanner is now handling recertification training. He is looking for our outside training resources for in-service training opportunities. M. Fasano now handling Basic training in addition to the CLESP program. Stressed that agency policies do not need to be verbatim the state policy but need to follow all the points of such policy. Human trafficking is now required annually. There will be a train the trainer class in July. There will be a commuter basic training class in July and a residential class in August.

PowerDMS: State and CLESP program for agencies already using PowerDMS for CALEA will be \$250 each.

New Business: Reminder 2019-2020 \$50 per year dues invoice is available on the CONNPAC website: Those whom have not yet paid are encouraged to do.

Other Business:

Police Accountability Bill passed. Mandates a new task force on police transparency and accountability, Use of force reporting to OMP. Body /Dash camera video will need to be released within 96 hours of incident with injury.

Injury Bill- Allows for agency to grant full salary to officer retiring due to injury in line of duty.
