

## CONN PAC MEETING MINUTES

**Date:** October 6, 2016

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes of August 5<sup>th</sup> meeting presented for review. Motion made by Meridan and seconded by POST to accept minutes as presented. Vote: Unanimous. Motion carries.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer's report presented. Balance is \$2,348.71. Motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented made by POSTC and seconded by Meridan. Vote: Unanimous. Motion carried. Currently 35 agencies have paid 2016-2017 dues.

**Introductions:** Lt. TJ White, Darien Accreditation Manager and Lt Salvator, Bloomfield Accreditation Manager.

**Old Business:** Mock Onsite: Madison Mock showed more work needed on Communication Standards. Assessment will be December 11.

Simsbury needs mock January as onsite will be in March.

CALEA update: PAC Presidents conference call today. Chief Kulhawik will participate.

Conference in Charleston, SC, Nov. 2-5, 2016. Enfield, UCONN, Bethel and Bloomfield all attending.

POST Update: B. Tanner advises the Accreditation manager position is not being funded even on a part time basis. The State is looking to cut an additional \$150,000 from the POST budget which will likely come from in-service training.

### **New Business:**

Meeting time change: Linda Carlin suggests moving the meeting to the afternoon and Chief Kulhawik suggests the potential of quarterly meetings. After discussion will be left as is for now.

CALEA Conference: July 2017 will be held in Providence. RI State Police has not sought any assistance from the PAC.

Training: Chief Kulhawik will put out an email for volunteers for a training committee to research training opportunities.

Family Violence Policy: Monroe inquiry about the State Advocate whom seemed to put out a hit list. It appears she wants the 36 page model policy adopted intact by local PDs. CPCA and Chief Kulhawik

met with her. She seems to think she has her marching orders and is not budging from her position. Butch Hyatt, whom took over Joe Froelich's position is trying to work with Chief's. Many PDs are adopting the policy intact.

Discussion over Washington POST article regarding DOJ problems with diversity in PDs is because of background checks being too strict that it may have disparate impact.

RI PAC: Madison advises that Providence is launching a pilot body worn camera program and they are the only one in RI so far.

Motion made by POST and seconded by Milford to adjourn. Vote unanimous. Meeting Adjourned.
