Old Business:

POSTC Update:

Marc Fasano is the new Compliance to Law Enforcement Standards and Practices (CLESP) and CALEA Accreditation staff member. He is a retired North Haven PD Sgt. and was hired by POSTC in August. He has been meeting with Chiefs to explain the program. He will begin onsite to check compliance in January 2019. CLESP to include 16 standards: Bias based policing, Complaint handling, Pursuits, Missing persons, Family violence, Selection and Testing, Body worn cameras, Eyewitness Identification procedures, Deaths, Recruitment retention and promotion of minority officers, Serious mental illness, Sexual Assault, Electronic defense weapons, Juveniles in custody reporting, Human Trafficking training, Use of Force. Anticipated it will be voted on at the November POSTC meeting.

POSTC Committee chaired by Bill Wright is working on the pursuit form.

Bill Tanner will continue to handle State Accreditation and is working on revising the Evidence standard.

CALEA update: Your CIMRS login is the same for years 2 through 4 that you are sent in year 1. There will only be approximately 10 days a year that you can't get into the system when reports are being reviewed. Firing Range standard in Advanced applies even if you use someone else's range.

Quarterly performance evaluations are no longer needed.

30 minute face to face holding facility checks is still under review.

In 4th year of review, CSM will mostly check the standards they have not yet reviewed but can review all.

Next CALEA conference is May 2019 then November 2019.

Other Business: 2018-2019 Dues- Currently 39 paid agencies. For those that have not yet paid the invoice is on the CONNPAC website. All who do not pay by November 1, 2018 will be removed from website access.
